## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH YAMHILL RIVER, a tributary of YAMHILL RIVER for the purposes of IRRIGATION of 27.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-19363. The date of priority is MARCH 31, 1950. The amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.34 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:
