 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CRIMSON WEST FARMS, INC.  
 ROUTE 3 BOX 118  
 MCMINNVILLE, OREGON 97128

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH YAMHILL RIVER, a tributary of YAMHILL RIVER for the purpose of IRRIGATING 162.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-43966. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 28, 1979. This right is limited to 2.03 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 64516, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAR 30 2015, approving Transfer Application T-11478.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
