 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of TEMPERANCE CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF SNAKE RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 52.03 ACRES AND DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE LAWN AND NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN.

This right was perfected under Permit S-48828. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 10, 1982. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.301 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 1.30 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.001 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484 and ORS 536.075. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 183.484, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate within three months after issuance of the certificate.


This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.
