This right was perfected under Permit S-33691. The date of priority is June 17, 1968. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.13 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.
