CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of CONNER CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF DAVIS CREEK, AND A RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-11036, FOR IRRIGATION, FLOOD HARVESTING OF CRANBERRIES AND TEMPERATURE CONTROL ON 26.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-50529. The date of priority is MARCH 9, 1988. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 3.9 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.65 CFS FOR IRRIGATION, 1.3 CFS FOR FLOOD HARVESTING AND 3.9 CFS FOR TEMPERATURE CONTROL or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

30 S	15 W	WM	13	NE NW	DIVERSION #2 – 35 FEET SOUTH AND 200 FEET WEST FROM N1/4 CORNER, SECTION 13

If water is used for the irrigation of cranberries, this appropriation shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. If water is used for the irrigation of any other crop, this appropriation shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484 and ORS 536.075. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 183.484, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate within three months after issuance of the certificate.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

If required by the Department, the water user shall record and submit annually to the Water Resources Department all pertinent data pertaining to use of water for temperature control on forms furnished by the Department.


This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.

The right to use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
