CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of CATHERINE CREEK, tributary to GRANDE RONDE RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 29.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-3852. The date of priority is JULY 1, 1918. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.37 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

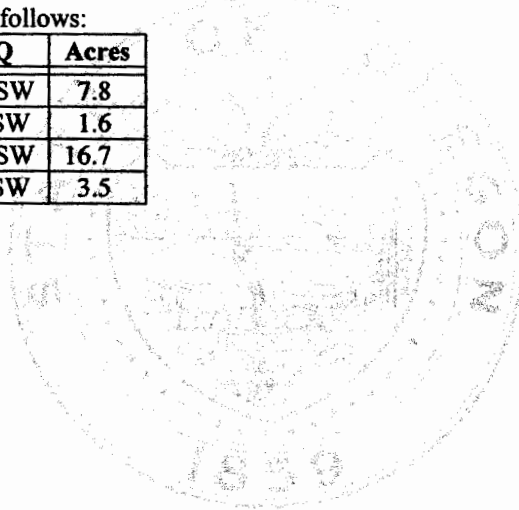
The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
5 S	42 E	WM	24	SE NE	90 FEET NORTH AND 1150 FEET WEST FROM E1/4 CORNER, SECTION 24

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JULY 11, 2006, at Special Order Volume 69, Page 51, approving Transfer Application 9904, together with Certificate 82104, supercedes Certificate 32251, State record of Water Right Certificates.
