CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

EARL RANDALL SWECK

confirms the right to use the waters of COTTONWOOD CREEK, tributary to NORTH FORK JOHN DAY RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 3.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-34281. The date of priority is DECEMBER 3, 1968. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.10 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed 0.10 cubic foot per second and that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 9, 1989, at Special Order Volume 43, Page 284, approving Transfer Application 5966, and together with Certificates 68391, 68392, and 68393, supercedes Certificate 44181, State record of Water Right Certificates.
