confirms the right to use the waters of the SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of the UMPQUA RIVER for QUASI-MUNICIPAL USE.

This right was perfected under Permit S-24600. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 19, 1956. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.25 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source, and shall not exceed 50.0 acre-feet during the irrigation season of each year.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described; however, water may be applied to lands which are not specifically described above, provided the holder of this right complies with ORS 540.510(3).

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in PLACE OF USE, CHARACTER OF USE, AND POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 9, 1998, at Special Order Volume 52, Page 1074, approving Transfer Application 7959, and together with Certificate 75738, supersedes Certificate 26256, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
