## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

VANCE A. TUCKER ALICE E. TUCKER 46404 ROCK CREEK TOWN RD HAINES OR 97833

confirms the right to use the waters of ROCK CREEK, tributary to POWDER RIVER for IRRIGATION of 1.64 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is JUNE 1886.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.041 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTHIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted at each point of diversion.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION AND PARTIAL CANCELLATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 17, 2001, at Special Order Volume 55, Page 1315, approving Transfer Application 8755, and together with Certificate 79012, supercedes Certificate 3976, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
