 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MRS ANNIE REINOEHL
 HOOD RIVER, OR 97031

confirms the right to use the waters of WASTE WATER, from the SW¹/₄ SE ¹/₄, SECTION 10, T. 2 N, R 10E. W.M. a tributary to the HOOD RIVER for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 7.45 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-13976. The date of priority is AUGUST 9, 1939. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.093 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q
2 N	10 E	WM	10	SW SE

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season and shall also be limited to the water available at the proposed point of diversion and shall not carry with it the right to divert water from the stream from which the waste water is diverted nor the right to require the wasteful use of water by others; provided further that the amount of water allowed herein together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 87087, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered APR 24 2015, approving Transfer Application T-11935.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use herein described.
