 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

H. M. KNAPP  
 ROUTE 2, BOX 795  
 ROSEBURG, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER for the purpose of IRRIGATION of 14.47 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-22870. The date of priority is MARCH 26, 1954. The amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.18 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant is as follows:


Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows: Lot 1 Plat E Roseburg Home Orchard Tracts

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
