confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the KLAMATH LAKE BASIN for ALGAE GROWTH REDUCTION IN THE CHANNELS OF HARBOR ISLES SUBDIVISION.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10090. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 17, 1982. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1000 GALLONS PER MINUTE or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

All data pertaining to the use of water, including pumping times, quantity and temperature, shall be submitted annually to the Water Resources Department.

The right established herein shall be subordinate and inferior to any future right for beneficial consumptive use from the same aquifer.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a useable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine water level elevation in the wells at all times.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484 and ORS 536.075. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 183.484, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate within three months after issuance of the certificate.

The water user shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device and keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.
