 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED RESERVOIR, CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-8449, TRIBUTARY OF BIG CREEK for CRANBERRY OPERATIONS ON 26.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-52989. The date of priority is JANUARY 16, 1990. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 250.0 ACRE FEET or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The period of allowed use is year round.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water diverted for CRANBERRY OPERATIONS, together with amounts secured under any other rights existing for the same lands, is limited as follows: For temperature control, 0.15 cubic foot per second per acre. For flood harvesting or pest control, 0.05 cubic foot per second per acre. For irrigation of cranberries, ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second and 3.0 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. For the irrigation of any other crop, the amount of water diverted is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre feet per acre during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484 and ORS 536.075. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 183.484, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate within three months after issuance of the certificate.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain, in good working order, a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Watermaster at each point of diversion. The totalizing flow meter must be installed and maintained as identified in OAR 690-507-645. The water user shall keep a complete record of the amount of water used each month. The water user shall submit a report which includes the recorded water use measurements to the Department at its request. The water user may be required to report annually or more frequently as may be required by the Director. Further, the Director may require the water user to report general water-use information, including the place and nature of use of water under the right.

In the event of a request for a change in point of appropriation, an additional point of appropriation or alteration of the appropriation facility associated with this authorized diversion, the quantity of water allowed herein, together with any other right, shall not exceed the capacity of the facility at the time of perfection of this right.

The water user shall maintain and operate fish screening as required by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to prevent fish from entering the diversion.

Diversion and use of water under this right must comply with the Clean Water Act and utilize best management practices as identified in the plan developed as specified in the New River Alternative Dispute Resolution Team Agreement on file with the Department.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
