CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

PINE MEADOW RANCH INC.

confirms the right to use the waters of SQUAW [WHYCHUS] CREEK, tributary to DESCHUTES RIVER for IRRIGATION of 22.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Pages 120 and 471. The date of priority thereby confirmed is 1906.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.44 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the meter or other suitable measuring device in good working order.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of diversion.

The water user shall operate and maintain the fish screen at the new point of diversion consistent with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW)'s operational and maintenance standards. If ODFW determines the screen is not functioning properly, and is unsuccessful in working with the water user to meet ODFW standards, ODFW may request that OWRD regulate the use of water until OWRD receives notification from ODFW that the fish screen is functioning properly.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 28, 2014, at Special Order Volume 91, Page 903, approving Transfer Application 11686, and together with Certificates 89110, 89346, and 90315, supercedes Certificate 75141, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
