CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RICK A. HUFSTADER AND CYNTHIA STICKLAND

confirms the right to use the waters of JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 7.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-18828. The date of priority is JUNE 28, 1949. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.185 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

13 S	29 E	WM	18	SW SE	NEW POINT OF DIVERSION - 590 FEET NORTH AND 1980 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 18

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion not to exceed FIVE ACRE-FEET per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1 to September 30 of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water use measurement conditions:


- A. The water user shall maintain the meter or other suitable measuring device in good working order at the new point of diversion.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall operate and maintain an approved fish screen at the new point of diversion.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in point of diversion and place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 3, 2014, at Special Order Volume 91, Page 898, approving Transfer Application 11454, and together with Certificate 89114, supercedes Certificate 86539, State record of Water Right Certificates.
