confirms the right to use the waters of MILL CREEK, a tributary to OCHOCO CREEK, a tributary of CROOKED RIVER for the purpose of the IRRIGATION of 54.1 ACRES of land.

This right was perfected under Permit S-1119. The date of priority is MARCH 18, 1912. The amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.71 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversions, together with that diverted at the original point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

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Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain and operate fish screening as required by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to prevent fish from entering the diversion.

Notwithstanding that Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife has made a determination by-pass devices are not necessary at this time, the water user may be required in the future to install, maintain, and operate by-pass devices to prevent fish from entering the diversion, and to provide adequate upstream and downstream passage for fish.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE and ADDITIONAL POINTS OF DIVERSION, approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 21, 2003 at Special Order Volume 57, Page 1100, approving Transfer Application T-8732 and corrected by Special Order Volume 57 page 1307 on August 12, 2003, and, supersedes Certificate 939, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
