CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CHRIS AND KATHY SCHELLER  
6061 SW MERIDIAN WAY  
TUALATIN, OR 97062

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the TUALATIN RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION of 4.18 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-9281. The date of priority is MARCH 20, 1981. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

2 S	1 E	WM	31	SE NW	352 FEET NORTH AND 1716 FEET EAST FROM THE W1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation described as follows:

2 S	1 E	WM	31	SE NW	550 FEET NORTH AND 1850 FEET EAST FROM THE W1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31

A totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device is not required at this time; however, when it becomes necessary in the future the Department may require one to be installed.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use.

This certificate is issued to confirm A NEW POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 27, 2014, at Special Order Volume 92, Page 601, approving Transfer Application 11675, together with Certificate 89187, supercedes Certificate 62489, State record of Water Right Certificates.
