## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

#### THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

## BRAD ALLEN JUNE ALLEN 48748 MCCARTY BRIDGE RD NORTH POWDER OR 97867

confirms the right to use the waters of POWDER RIVER, a tributary of the SNAKE RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 430.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-31402. The date of priority is MARCH 15, 1966. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 7.42 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3½ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain a headgate, or an in-line flow meter for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted at all points of diversion. When required by the Department, the water user or irrigation district shall operate and maintain the headgate and measuring device, as needed. The Watermaster may operate the headgate and monitor the accuracy of the measuring device, as needed.

The water user shall begin a diversion monitoring program that shall include the rate and duty of water appropriated. The flow data shall be available to the Watermaster promptly on request. The water user shall supply to the Watermaster promptly upon request an annual report of water use and monitoring data. Monitoring data shall be provided to the Watermaster in a reasonable summary format, approved by the Watermaster, upon request.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen on the pump locations.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.

This certificate is issued to confirm ADDITIONAL POINTS OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 15, 2002, at Special Order Volume 56, Page 305, approving Transfer Application 8430, supercedes Certificate 48330, State record of Water Right Certificates.
