CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BLOUNT INC. OREGON CUTTING SYSTEMS DIVISION PO BOX 22127 PORTLAND OR 97269-2127

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED RESERVOIR, CONSTRUCTED UNDER APPLICATION R-72732, PERMIT R-12091, AND MINTHORNE SPRINGS CREEK, tributaries of MT. SCOTT CREEK for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 6.5 ACRES AND RESERVOIR MAINTENANCE.

This right was perfected under Permit S-52963. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 25, 1992. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 2.8 ACRE FEET PER YEAR FROM STORED WATER FOR IRRIGATION, AND 0.008 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FROM MINTHORNE SPRINGS CREEK FOR RESERVOIR MAINTENANCE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The period of use is March 1 through October 31.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate at any time before it has issued, and after the time has expired for the completion of the appropriation under the permit, or within three months after issuance of the certificate.

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Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the meter, or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director, in good working order.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- C. The Director may require the water user to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the water user to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the water user to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the right. The Director may provide an opportunity for the water user to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

In the event of a request for a change in point of appropriation, an additional of appropriation or alteration of the appropriation facility associated with this authorized diversion, the quantity of water allowed herein, together with any other right, shall not exceed the capacity of the facility of this right.

The use may be restricted if the quality of the source stream, namely the Willamette River, decreases to the point that it no longer meets existing state and federal water quality standards due to reduced flows.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.
