 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of WEST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER, tributary to ILLINOIS RIVER for COMMERCIAL FISH PONDS.

This right was perfected under Permit S-13214. The date of priority is AUGUST 13, 1938 FOR 1.0 CFS, AND OCTOBER 26, 1938 FOR 0.85 CFS. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.85 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
40 S	9 W	WM	25	SE NE	320 FEET SOUTH AND 470 FEET EAST FROM NE1/16 CORNER, SECTION 25

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q
40 S	9 W	WM	25	SE NE

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q
40 S	9 W	WM	26	NW SW

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.

The former place of use shall no longer receive water as a part of this water right.

When required by the Department, the water user shall work with the watermaster to develop and implement a strategy for insuring the separation of water used for fish culture and for irrigation.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEPTEMBER 16, 1997, at Special Order Volume 51, Page 1065, approving Transfer Application 7257, supersedes Certificate 14192, State record of Water Right Certificates.
