confirms the right to use the waters of WILLOW CREEK, tributary to COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 46.81 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Morrow County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 73. The date of priority is MARCH 1894 FOR 39.9 ACRES AND 1908 FOR 6.91ACRES

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.78 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.665 CFS FOR PRIORITY DATE MARCH 1894 AND 0.115 CFS FOR PRIORITY DATE 1908, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-SIXTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, during the irrigation season of each year.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion, together with that diverted at the old points of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original points of diversion.

When required by the Department, the water users shall install and maintain headgates, in-line flow meters, weirs, or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgates and measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original points of diversion.


The water user shall maintain fish screens or fish by-pass devices.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm additional POINTS OF DIVERSION, approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 21, 2001, at Special Order Volume 55, Page 1212, approving Transfer Application 6754, and together with Certificate 78514, supercedes Certificate 170, State record of Water Right Certificates.
