CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL, in the BUCK CREEK BASIN for IRRIGATION of 286.5 ACRES.

This right, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 68712, was perfected under Permit G-7361. The date of priority is APRIL 29, 1977. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 3.58 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with the quantity diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation described as follows:

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The following provision shall be effective when in the judgement of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install measuring devices:

the pump system shall include an access port for measuring the water level;

the pump system shall include an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the user is entitled;


the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 1, 1997, at Special Order Volume 51, Page 1325, approving Transfer Application 7217, and together with Certificate 75331, supersedes Certificate 68712, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
