 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the GRAVEL PIT NUMBER 3 (SUMP) IN THE PINE CREEK (POWDER RIVER) BASIN for IRRIGATION of 6.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-2877. The date of priority is APRIL 14, 1965. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.07 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well (sump).

The new point of appropriation (new pump station) is located as follows:

8 S	39 E	WM	29	NW SW	EAST BANK OF GRAVEL PIT 3 - 700 FEET SOUTH AND 280 FEET EAST FROM W ¼ CORNER, SECTION 29

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (pump station), together with the quantity diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation described as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 20, 1998, at Special Order Volume 52, Page 741, approving Transfer Application 7933, and together with Certificate 75775, supercedes Certificate 68435, State record of Water Right Certificates.
