CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL HARN 51706 in the MALHEUR LAKE BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 122.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10390. The date of priority is MARCH 26, 1984. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.525 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of appropriation is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The wells shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine water level elevation within the well at all times. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

This certificate is issued in accordance with OAR 690-380-6010 to describe the water right for a noncompleted additional point of appropriation approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 27, 2000, at Special Order Volume 54, Page 744, amending Transfer Application T-8109 and supersedes a portion of Certificate 76398, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
