CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of LONG CANYON, tributary to WILEY CANYON, for IRRIGATION of 29.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-2819. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 26, 1916. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.37 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The Director may require the water user to install a meter or other suitable measuring device at each point of diversion. If the Director notifies the water user to install totalizing flow meters or other measuring devices, the water user shall install such device specified by the Director within the period stated in the notice. Once installed, the water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order and shall allow the watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 16, 2009, at Special Order Volume 78, Page 128, approving Transfer Application 8416, supersedes Certificate 2761, State record of Water Right Certificates.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
