CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

KEN AND MARIA CADE
 PO BOX 26
 FORT ROCK OR 97735

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL 2 (NEW) in the FORT ROCK VALLEY BASIN for IRRIGATION of 75.01 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10701. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 3, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.938 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation described as follows:

28 S	16 E	WM	10	SW NW	ORIGINAL WELL - 1320 FEET SOUTH AND 1320 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 10

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The water user shall maintain a weir, meter or other suitable measuring device to keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The water user shall maintain in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated at the new point of appropriation.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in POINT OF APPROPRIATION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCTOBER 6, 2010, at Special Order Volume 82, Page 36, approving Transfer Application 10231, together with Certificate 86621, supersedes Certificate 83586, State record of Water Right Certificates.
