confirms the right to use the waters of MCKAY CREEK, tributary to UMATILLA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 1.88 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-14294. The date of priority is APRIL 13, 1940. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.036 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

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The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device as approved by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 25, 1998 at Special Order Volume 52, Page 250, approving Transfer Application 7665, and supercedes Certificate 53298, State record of Water Right Certificates.
