CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

TIM CLEMENS
235 HWY 20 N
HINES, OR 97738

confirms the right to use the waters of FOUR WELLS within the MALHEUR LAKE BASIN for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 260.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit U-259. The date of priority is AUGUST 26, 1948. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 3.09 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), further limited to 0.87 CFS from Well 1, 0.87 CFS from Well 2, 0.87 CFS from Well 3, and 1.05 CFS from Well 4, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the wells shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation, described as follows:


The water user shall maintain a totalizing flow meter or other suitable device at each point of appropriation.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm the change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 7, 2009, at Special Order Volume 79, Page 311, approving Transfer Application 10606, and together with Certificate 85943, supersedes Certificate 51197, State record of Water Right Certificates.
