CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ROBERT U MACE TESTAMENTARY CHARITABLE TRUST  
183 GRESHAM ST  
ASHLAND OR 97520

confirms the right to use the waters of ROGUE RIVER, tributary to PACIFIC OCEAN for year round INDUSTRIAL USE.

This right was perfected under Permit S-25859, as modified by T-8294. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 18, 1958. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.33 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, further limited to a volume of 118.35 acre feet each year, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the point of diversion may occur year-round at a rate not to exceed 0.33 CFS on a non-continuous basis and shall be further limited to a total volume of water diverted not to exceed 118.35 acre-feet per year.

The water user shall maintain and operate the existing measurement device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted, and shall make improvements as may be required by the Director.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the supervision of the Department.

The water user shall maintain and operate fish screening and by-pass devices that have been approved by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in the CHARACTER OF USE and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEPTEMBER 27, 2007, at Special Order Volume 73, Page 337, approving Transfer Application 9968, supersedes Certificate 82241, State record of Water Right Certificates.
