CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DALLAS OR 97338

confirms the right to use water from a RESERVOIR ENLARGED UNDER PERMIT R-5934, a tributary of SALT CREEK, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 53.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-36631. The date of priority is DECEMBER 20, 1971. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 2.69 ACRE FEET, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOVEMBER 8, 1994 at Special Order Volume 48, Page 337, approving Transfer Application 6843, and together with Certificate 64819, supersedes Certificate 42975, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
