CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS in the WEST FORK HOOD RIVER BASIN for FISH CULTURE.

This right was perfected under Permit G-8110. The date of priority is APRIL 28, 1978. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.79 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.22 CFS FROM WELL 1 AND 0.57 CFS FROM WELL 2, if available at the original well, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with the quantity of diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation.


When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 8, 1997, at Special Order Volume 51, Page 1351, approving Transfer Application 7847, and supercedes Certificate 55582, State record of Water Right Certificates.
