CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of RINK CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF COQUILLE RIVER for COMMERCIAL USE IN GREENHOUSES AND IRRIGATION of 2.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-46183. The date of priority is JUNE 3, 1981. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.025 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.005 CFS FOR USE IN GREENHOUSES, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

28 S	12 W	WM	8	SW NW	740 FEET NORTH AND 650 FEET EAST FROM WEST 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 8

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484 and ORS 536.075. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 183.484, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate within three months after issuance of the certificate.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
