 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MIKE AND LEATRICE BRUMBACH

confirms the right to use the waters of the WALLA WALLA RIVER, a tributary of Columbia River, for IRRIGATION of 1.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-7237. The date of priority is March 16, 1926. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.010 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (cfs) or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

5 N	35 E	WM	1	NE NW	1080 FEET SOUTH AND 450 FEET WEST FROM THE NORTH ¼ CORNER OF SECTION 1

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-ONE HUNDRED TWENTIETH of one cfs per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 86269 State Record of Water Right Certificates, REDUCED IN RATE by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered DEC 18 2015, approving Allocation of Conserved Water CW-46, and together with Certificate 90630, supersedes Certificate 86269.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
