CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of FALL CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF ILLINOIS RIVER for DOMESTIC USE FOR TWO FAMILIES AND IRRIGATION of 7.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-42804. The date of priority is OCTOBER 24, 1977. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.01 CFS FOR DOMESTIC AND 0.03 CFS FOR IRRIGATION or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

35 S	11 W	WM	18	SE NE	1795 FEET SOUTH AND 765 FEET EAST FROM SE CORNER, LOT 4 (SWSE), SECTION 7

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FIFTIETH, of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.



NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484 and ORS 536.075. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 183.484, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate within three months after issuance of the certificate.
