CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of SEVEN WELLS, BEING LIBRARY WELL 3, SETTLEMIER WELL 4, NAZARENE WELL 7, LEGION PARK WELL 8, DONNER WELL 9, CENTENNIAL WELL 10, AND ASTOR WAY WELL 11, in the MILL CREEK BASIN, for MUNICIPAL USE.

This right was perfected under Permit G-2593. The date of priority is JANUARY 24, 1964 for 1.0 cubic foot per second (CFS) and MARCH 30, 1964 for 0.11 CFS. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.11 CFS, further limited to no more than 0.76 CFS from LIBRARY WELL 3 and 1.11 CFS each from SETTLEMIER WELL 4, NAZARENE WELL 7, LEGION PARK WELL 8, DONNER WELL 9, CENTENNIAL WELL 10, AND ASTOR WAY WELL 11, in any combination, or its equivalent in case of rotation measured at the wells.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install in-line flow meters, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in place of use and points of appropriation, approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 22, 1997, at Special Order Volume 51, Page 1013, and as amended on July 12, 1999, at Special Order Volume 53, Page 1041, approving Transfer Application 7656, supercedes Certificate 36537, State record of Water Right Certificates.
