 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of a WELL in the ROCK CREEK BASIN (JOHN DAY RIVER) for IRRIGATION of 19.5 ACRES, and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 12.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-3458. The date of priority is MARCH 22, 1967. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.39 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
