CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ARGYLE WINERY, INC.

confirms the right to use the waters of WILLAMETTE RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 44.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-35203. The date of priority is JUNE 10, 1970, PLUS ONE MINUTE. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.25 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of 1/178.5 of ONE CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND PER ACRE, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 58.0 ACRE-FEET, and 1.3 ACRE FEET PER ACRE for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant is as follows:

The user shall maintain an in-line flow meter that totalizes volume, or similar device approved by the Director for measuring the amount of water diverted, in good working order and shall allow the watermaster access to the meter; provided, however, where the meter is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm the finalization of allocation of conserved water application CW-3 in an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 26, 2004, at Special Order Volume 59, Page 255, Final Order Approving the Use of the Conserved Water, in the matter of allocation of conserved water application CW-3, and together with Certificates 80617, 80618, and 80619, supersedes Certificate 52400, State record of Water Right Certificates.
