CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

FOUNTAIN SEACAT
BAKER, OR

confirms the right to use the waters of WASHINGTON GULCH, tributary of POWDER RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATION of 120.28 ACRES of land.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is 1867.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 4446, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 3, 2015, approving Transfer Application T-11979.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purpose is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
