## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STANFIELD HUTTERIAN BRETHREN 36345 DESPAIN GULCH RD STANFIELD OR 97875

confirms the right to use the waters of COLUMBIA RIVER, a tributary of PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATION of 94.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-37833. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 26, 1975. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.26 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

## NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall operate and maintain an approved fish screen at the point of diversion. If the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) determines that the screen is not functioning properly, and is unsuccessful in working with the water user to meet ODFW standards, ODFW may request that OWRD regulate the use of water until OWRD receives notification from ODFW that the fish screen is functioning properly.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director JANUARY 29, 2015, at Special Order Volume 93, Page 1210, approving Transfer Application 11770, and together with Certificate 86541, supersedes Certificate 87073, State record of Water Right Certificates.
