CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JAMES A. ARMSTRONG  
475 LITTLE APPLGATE ROAD  
JACKSONVILLE OR 97530

confirms the right to use the waters of LITTLE APPLGATE RIVER, a tributary of APPLGATE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 40.92 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 56492. The decree recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1854.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.16 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, if available at the authorized point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 8, 2004, at Special Order Volume 61, Page 424, approving Transfer Application 8963, and together with Certificate 80955, supercedes Certificate 56492, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
