CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILLIAM H SPROWL, JR
527 HOTEL PLAZA
BOULDER CITY NEVADA 89005

confirms the right to use the waters of WEST FORK OF WILLIAMS CREEK, tributary to APPLGATE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 8.21 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1880.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.14 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

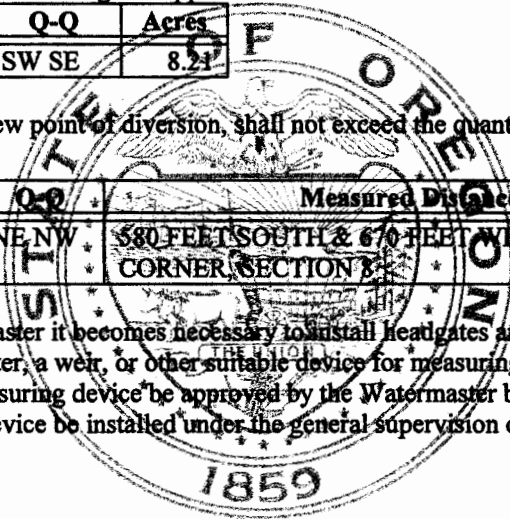
A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Acres
39 S	5 W	WM	5	SW SE	8.21

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion, described as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
39 S	5 W	WM	8	NE NW	580 FEET SOUTH & 670 FEET WEST FROM N 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 8

When in the judgement of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices, the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the water user is entitled. The type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.




NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 25, 1986, at Special Order Volume 40, Page 477, approving Transfer Application 5838, and together with Certificate 60842, supersedes Certificate 44001, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
