CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary to the UMPQUA RIVER for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE HOUSEHOLD, IRRIGATION OF 2.2 ACRES AND LIVESTOCK WATER.

This right was perfected under Permit S-43279. The date of priority is MAY 18, 1978. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.0356 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.005 CFS FOR HOUSEHOLD USE, 0.0026 CFS FOR STOCKWATER, AND 0.028 CFS FOR IRRIGATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


The use of water allowed herein may be made only at time when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 90075, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered DEC 30 2015, approving Transfer Application T-12052.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
