CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That W. G. ALLEN

, has made proof Oregon , State of to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Jones and Finney Lakes and stream

for the purpose of a tributary of Willemette River

Irrigation of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters under Permit No. 7258 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 30, 1926;

that the amount of water to which such right is cutified and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.0 cubic feet per second;

The point of diversion is located in the BEANHA of Section 12 , Township 68 , Range 31, W. M. The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per

acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the lands irrigated under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is apportenant (if for irrigation or any other purpose), is as follows: 12 acres in the SHASHA, Section 1, 9 acres in the SEASHA, 15 acres in the NEASEA, 9 acres in the NHASEA, 30 acres in the SEASHA, Section 2, 32 acres in the NEANEA, 12 acres in the SEANEA, Section 11, 5 acres in the NEANEA, 33 acres in the NEANEA, 35 acres in the SEANEA, acres in the SEANEA, Section 12, SECTION 13, SECTION 12, SECTION 13, SECTION 14, SECTION 14, SECTION 15, SECTION 12, SECTION 15, SECTION Township 6 South, Range 3 West, Willamotte Meridian, in Marion County, Oregon, being a total of 240 acres.

The right to the use of the water for any purpose is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

After the expiration of fifty years from the date of this certificate or on the expiration of any federal power license issued in connection with this right, and after not less than two years notice in writing to the holder hereof, the State of Oregon, or any municipality thereof, shall have the right to take over the dams, plants and other structures and all appurtenances thereto which have been constructed for the purpose of devoting to beneficial use the water rights specified herein, upon condition that before taking possession the State or municipality shall pay not to exceed the fair value of the property so taken, plus such reasonable damages, if any, to raluable, serviceable and dependable property of the holder of this certificate, not taken over, as may be caused by the severance therefrom of the property taken in accordance with the provisions of section 5728, Oregon Laws.
