## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

Silver Lake Oregon , State of , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Lenz Creek, sometimes called Big Springs Creek

Irrigation, including stock watering for the purpose of

under Permit No. 7574 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby May 29, 1926; confirmed dates from

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 16.5 cubic feet per second;

The point of diversion is located in the NWENE of Section 27 . Township 308 . Range 8E . W. M. The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the lands irrigated under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenent (if for irrigation or any other purpose), is as follows: 133 acres in the E3E, Section 23, 40 acres in the SM2SM4, Section 25, 80 acres in the SM2SM4, Section 26, 320 acres in the E2, Section 35, 320 acres in the N2, 160 acres in the SW1, 80 acres in the W2SE4, Section 36, Township 30 South, Range 8 East, and 160 acres in the NEG, Section 2, Township 31 South, Range 8 East, Willemette Meridian, in Klamath County, Oregon, being a total of 1,320 acres.

The right to the use of the water for any purpose is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

After the expiration of fifty years from the date of this certificate or on the expiration of any federal power license issued in connection with this right, and after not less than two years notice in writing to the holder hereof, the State of Oregon, or any municipality thereof, shall have the right to take over the dams, plants and other structures and all appurtenances thereto which have been constructed for the purpose of devoting to beneficial use the water rights specified herein, upon condition that before taking possession the State or municipality shall pay not to exceed the fair value of the property so taken, plus such reasonable damages, if any, to raluable, serviceable and dependable property of the holder of this certificate, not taken over, as may be caused by the severance therefrom of the property taken in accordance with the provisions of section 5728, Oregon Laws.
