CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILLOW VALLEY IRRIGATION DISTRICT C/O DARREL D. BAGLEY 14575 E. LANGELL VALLEY RD. BONANZA, OR 97623

confirms the right to use the waters of WILLOW VALLEY RESERVOIR constructed under Permits R-628, R-979 and R-2631, BUMPHEAD RESERVOIR constructed under Permit R-2162, AND THREE MILE FLAT RESERVOIR constructed under Permits R-980 and R-11257, tributaries of LOST RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 40.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-51109. The date of priority is JUNE 16, 1981. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND from STORED WATER ONLY, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the sources.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

THREE MILE FLAT RESERVOIR - 1410 FEET NORTH AND 2600 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 3, being within the NE ¼ SW ¼ SECTION 3, Township 41 South, Range 14 East, W.M.

WILLOW VALLEY RESERVOIR - 50 FEET SOUTH AND 550 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 19, being within LOT 1 (NW 1/4 NW 1/4) of Section 19, Township 41 South, Range 14.5 East, W.M.

BUMPHEAD RESERVOIR - 1700 FEET NORTH AND 2500 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 31, being within the NE ¼ SW ¼ of Section 31, Township 40 South, Range 14.5 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This project was considered and approved by the Water Resources Commission October 26, 1990

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484 and ORS 536.075. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 183.484, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate within three months after issuance of the certificate.
