This right was perfected under Permit G-5218. The date of priority is MAY 16, 1973. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.89 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), further limited to no more than 0.55 CFS from each well, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 183.484, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate within three months after issuance of the certificate.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine the water level elevation in the well at all times.

The water user shall maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.
