CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of an UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of DREWS CREEK, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 78.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-41244. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 15, 1976. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.40 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

40 S	19 E	WM	18	NE NE	1500 FEET NORTH AND 1890 FEET EAST FROM THE C/4 OF SECTION 18.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


This certificate describes the water right confirmed by Certificate 49058, State Record of Water Right Certificates, diminished by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered APR 11 2016, approving Permit Amendment Application T-11937. This certificate supersedes Certificate 49058.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
