confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH FORK OF WALLOWA RIVER, tributary of the WALLOWA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 5.0 ACRES, DOMESTIC AND STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wallowa County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State Water Board of the State of Oregon in Volume 5, at Pages 155-156. The date of priority is MAY 1897.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.5 acre-feet per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31st of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1.0 acre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season, if available at the authorized point of diversion: CLEARWATER DITCH

The points of diversion are located as follows:

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion, together with that diverted at the old points of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion (Clearwater Ditch).

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.

The appropriator shall record and report total flow figures when requested by the Watermaster.


NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 26, 2003, at Special Order Volume 57, Page 156, approving Transfer Application 7671, together with Certificate 79891, supercedes Certificate 2982, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
