CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CECIL D. THOMPSON  
RT 1  
STANFIELD, OR 97875

confirms the right to use the waters of a SUMP, within the U. S. FEED CANAL and UMATILLA RIVER BASINS for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 1.72 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit G-2974. The date of priority is JULY 12, 1965. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.024 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the source.

The point of appropriation is located as follows:

4 N	28 E	WM	13	SE SW	1100 FEET NORTH AND 1110 FEET WEST FROM THE S¼ CORNER OF SECTION 13

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 ACRE-FEET per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 87319, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEB 12 2016, approving Transfer Application T-12218.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
