CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DAVLIN & NICHOLS
BROCKWAY, OR 97432

confirms the right to use the waters of LOOKINGGLASS CREEK, a tributary of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 5.25 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-10435. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 13, 1931. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.07 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate supersedes Certificate 11530 diminished by an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume 98, Page 772, entered FEBRUARY 19, 2016.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
